Adopting the Kansas Homeland Security Region H Hazard Mitigation Plan

Whereas, the City of Uniontown Recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and

Whereas, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and

Whereas, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (“Disaster Mitigation Act”) emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards;

Whereas, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local Governments; and

Whereas, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) pre- and post- disaster mitigation grant programs; and

Whereas, the City of Uniontown fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and the FEMA Region VII officials have reviewed the Kansas Homeland Security Region H Hazard Mitigation Plan, and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body; and

Whereas, the City of Uniontown desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Kansas Homeland Security Region H Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas, adoption by the governing body for the city of Uniontown demonstrates the jurisdictions’ commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this plan, and

Whereas, adoption of this legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan.

Now, therefore, be it resolved, that the City of Uniontown adopts the Kansas Homeland Security Region H Hazard Mitigation Plan as an official plan; and

Be it further resolved, that the City of Uniontown will submit this Adoption Resolution to the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and FEMA Region VII officials to enable the plan’s final approval.

CITY OF UNIONTOWN, Hereby authorizes Modern Copy Systems to maintain the machine(s) listed within this contract, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement.

MAINTENANCE SERVICE

The equipment will receive all the necessary maintenance during the term of this agreement, to include inspections, adjustments, cleaning and lubricating of the equipment covered. This maintenance will be performed during or separately from interim service calls, as scheduling will permit. Modern Copy Systems will replace without charge any parts found defective or which have become worn and require replacement as a result of normal and proper use of equipment (subject to parts availability). All service calls are without charge during normal Modern Copy Systems business hours. Calls performed outside of Modern Copy Systems normal business hours will be billed for (parts excluded). This agreement includes developer, drums and all other maintenance items. Due to the volatility of the fuel market, Modern Copy Systems reserves the right to charge a fuel surcharge.

CUSTOMER RESPONSIBILITY

The customer agrees to provide a suitable environment for the machine as specified by Modern Copy Systems, including adequate space with air conditioning and humidity control. Electrical power will be free of electrical surges, noise, and spikes and installed directly to a properly grounded outlet. The customer agrees to purchase all supplies from Modern Copy Systems.

SERVICE NOT INCLUDED IN AGREEMENT

Excluded from the terms of this maintenance agreement are any repairs or parts necessitated by carelessness or improper handling or use of equipment, damage by fire, floods, lightning, riots or acts of God, or any use of supplies other than those authorized by Modern Copy Systems. Modern Copy Systems is not responsible for external hardware or the connectivity of external hardware after initial installation. This agreement excludes toner and paper.
