SOFTWARE LICENSE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this ____ day of _____, 20 __, by and between:

INAalert, Inc

112 N. Main Street

(as "Licensor"),

and

City of Uniontown

206 Sherman St

Uniontown, KS 66779

(as "Licensee")

- A. Licensor has developed certain original, proprietary software and software support material referred to herein as the "Licensed Software" for use on personal computer systems including the Internet-based programming; and
- B. Licensee has requested a license to use the Licensed Software; and
- C. Licensor and Licensee desire to enter into an Agreement, whereby Licensee will obtain a license to use the product developed and supported by Licensor to be used for scheduling and staffing of personnel of Licensee.

THEREFORE THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **License** Licensor grants Licensee a license to use the Licensed Software solely within the terms and conditions set forth herein. So long as Licensee does not breach any terms of this Agreement, Licensee may use the Licensed Software throughout the length of this Agreement. Licensee agrees that any breach of this Agreement may be grounds for immediate termination of this license.
- 2. **Location of Licensed Software** The Licensed Software will be on Licensor's website and Licensee will have access to the same. Licensee agrees not to copy or attempt to copy the Licensed Software.
- 3. **Modification of Licensed Software** Licensee shall not modify or alter the Licensed Software in any way, and shall not sub-license, transfer, or otherwise assign the Licensed Software or this license to any other party without the prior written consent of Licensor, nor engage in any unauthorized distribution thereof, nor convert or attempt to convert the machine language into the source code of the Licensed Software, or attempt to reverse engineer the same. Licensee agrees that any violation of these provisions shall be grounds for the immediate termination of any rights Licensee may have pursuant to this Agreement, and may result in a claim against Licensee for damages.

4. **Ownership** Licensee acknowledges that Licensor owns and shall continue to own the Licensed Software and related manuals and materials, and all copies thereof and all applicable patent rights, copyrights, confidential information and trade secrets pertaining thereto. Licensee agrees to keep confidential all information pertaining to the Licensed Software and related manuals and materials, and agrees not to disclose such information without authorization to do so. Licensee further acknowledges that Licensor owns the trademarks of the Licensed Software.
5. **Defects and Enhancements** During the period of this Agreement, Licensor shall work with Licensee to correct any defects in the Licensed Software without additional charge. During this same period, Licensor will make available to Licensee, any enhancements it may make to the Licensed Software.
6. **Warranties** Licensee acknowledges that Licensor has made no express warranties with respect to the Licensed Software or any materials or information relating thereto. Licensee further understands and agrees that any liability from Licensor to Licensee shall be limited to actual damages, and Licensor shall not be liable to Licensee for any special, indirect or consequential damages of any kind arising in any manner from the Licensed Software or any materials or information relating thereto, or the use of the same. Licensee further acknowledges that Licensor has excluded from this Agreement all implied warranties and merchantability of fitness of the Licensed Software for a particular purpose.
7. **Confidentiality of Licensee Information** The information released by the Licensee in use of the software remains the property of the Licensee. Licensor agrees to provide secure hosting of the information, not to use the information for sales or marketing purposes, and not to divulge the information to any third person without the written consent of the Licensee.
8. **Compensation** For the use of the Licensed Software for the initial term of this Agreement, Licensor will bill Licensee the amount agreed upon between them, as reflected on Exhibit "A" attached hereto. The price may be subject to change with a thirty (30) day notification from Licensor to Licensee.
9. **Term and Termination** The Agreement shall begin on TBD, 2023, and shall continue from month to month thereafter unless terminated by either Licensor or Licensee by giving thirty (30) days notice to the other party. Within thirty (30) days after the termination of this Agreement, Licensee agrees to deliver to Licensor all manuals and materials related to the Licensed Software.
10. **Termination for Cause** Licensor or Licensee may terminate this Agreement with cause, immediately, as a result of a material breach of the terms and conditions contained herein. Written notice shall be provided to the offending party which shall include a statement identifying the material breach and/or default under this Agreement. The party to this Agreement who has been deemed in breach and/or default shall have ten (10) days to correct the same and if not corrected within said ten (10) days, this Agreement will fully terminate.

11. **Arbitration** In the event of a controversy between the parties arising out of the performance of the duties of either party pursuant to this Agreement, which cannot be resolved, either party may demand arbitration with respect to the controversy, pursuant to the Uniform Arbitration Act, Chapter 5, Article 4 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated. In the event of such demand, the parties shall agree upon an arbitrator and in the event of the failure of the parties to so agree, an arbitrator shall be appointed by the District Court of Barton County, Kansas on the application of either party, pursuant to K.S.A. 5-403. Arbitration shall be held in Great Bend, Barton County, Kansas unless the parties agree to conduct the arbitration at a different location.
12. **Independent Contractors** It is understood and agreed that the Licensee is an independent contractor with respect to the use of the Licensed Software and associated services, and Licensee is not the agent or employee of Licensor.
13. **Indemnity** Licensee agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Licensor, its employees, agents and representatives from and of any and all claims, actions and causes of action which may be made or brought against them, or any of them, as a result of Licensee's use of the Licensed Software and data inputted therein, which indemnity extends to the costs, expenses and attorney fees incurred by Licensor and its employees, agents and representatives arising from such claims, actions or causes of action being made or brought against it or them.
14. **Assignment** Neither party to this Agreement shall assign any rights and responsibilities under this Agreement to any person or entity without the prior written consent of the other party.
15. **Sole Agreement** This Agreement is the sole agreement between the parties related to the subject matter of this Agreement.
16. **Governing Law** This Agreement is being made under the laws of the state of Kansas and shall be construed and interpreted according to such laws.
