Established in 2007 and raising funds since 2009, Care to Share is a 501c3 organization that has received over \$1.4 million in grassroots giving from communities in Bourbon County, Crawford County, Linn County, and beyond.

With a 100% Volunteer staff, that means \$1.4 million has gone back into these communities to help our friends and families weather their cancer journeys as gracefully as possible.

In 2022 alone, Care to Share provided \$97,137.89 in gasoline needs and other personal concerns and for total return to our communities, add to that thousands of hours providing sunshine visits, rides, meals, chores, and even rent and utility payments.
