Purpose and Need											
This project is to replace an existing 26' PBMS spans bridge located on an asphalt roadway just east of Rock Creek Lake. 12-month inspection cycles is required. The bridge serves both mail and bus route in addition to residental, recreation and heavy agriculture use. This bridge is in very poor condition with extensive deterioration of girders (precast dbl units), several beam ends (bearing) have moderate/severe section loss and/or cracking and exposed corroded prestress strands (beams 3, 5, 6, 7 east abutment and beam 2 west abutment and beam 1 at midspan -serious condition. The masonry abutments have section loss and exposed footings in poor condition.
