Chairman Holt called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm in the Cleaver-Burris-Boileau Agriculture Building.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance, a prayer led by Welch, and Holt reading FSCC's mission statement.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC: None

RECOGNITIONS AND RETIREMENTS: Dr. Welch and Dr. Guerrero presented a certificate of appreciation to math instructor, Savannah Ashmore, for her coordination of the recent FSCC Math Relay. Dr. Welch presented certificates of appreciation to members of the Greyhound Student Leadership Organization. Member Cam Howard thanked the Board for their support of the Greyhound Student Leadership Organization.

PROGRAM REVIEW AND ADMINISTRATIVE UPDATES:

Director of Public Relations Taylor Bailey provided an overview of the FSCC marketing plan. TV commercials are being created by KOAM, and commercials will air over the next 2 months. She is also working on reusable commercials and billboard updates. Other updates included information about the weekly College Connection on KOMB Radio on Mondays at 8 am, Newshound in Tribune weekly, and upcoming work with Chris Goddard and Lindsay Hill on a podcast set to start in January. Lindsay Hill will be resuming Facebook Lives again beginning November 19. Weekly bulletins will expand their reach to local high schools soon and more physical signs will become present throughout Fort Scott. Taylor has a media team of 6 students.

Dr. Jay Allen, Director at the Pleasanton Campus, highlighted recent happenings at the Pleasanton Campus. Enrollment is currently at 141, and they anticipate more in the spring. The campus started a relationship with Build Up Kansas, and they were recently recognized by the Association of General Contractors. Open house will be on March 25, 2026. This will be a time for businesses to visit campus and meet with students.
