on the ground(s) that: (state specific grounds)

Failure to perform duties prescribed by law. During the 2025 General Election, the County Clerk caused to be printed and distributed incorrect ballots. Specifically, ballots used during early voting contained errors related to the USD 235 school board election. Despite the issue being brought to her attention by multiple individuals during the early voting period, the County Clerk failed to promptly correct the issue in a timely manner during that period, thereby allowing incorrect ballots to continue being used. Furthermore, the County Clerk represented that the ballots had been printed from official forms provided by the school district. This statement was later contradicted by testimony from the school superintendent. Corrective action was not taken until the night before the General Election, when new ballots were printed. This delay contributed to confusion and potential disenfranchisement of voters. The improper preparation, verification, and distribution of official ballots demonstrate a failure to perform the duties required of the office of County Clerk acting as County Election Officer under Chapter 25 of the Kansas Statutes.
